Hiking Story




This month the Droni team went on a hike to Borjomi. The landscape was amazing and hiking there at the same time was fantastic.






Droni's ESC volunteers

in any democratic society.





Our Droni member Oristine is in Estonia right now as a volunteer

"As you know I work with people with mental disabilities, my tasks are to teach them languages, math and play some interesting board games (like puzzles, different types of cards) which are really helpful for brain development, and also helps them to concentrate I use music therapy with our clients, they are really anxious and moody sometimes so music helps them to relax and changes their emotional state."



"My hosting organization has 6 units in Tartu, and in 2 of them new volunteers just arrived from the EU and we had a monthly meeting. While volunteering it's important to meet new people and share your experiences with them"

Anano's Interview


"Cities of YOUth" is an Erasmus+ project.

As we are participating in the 'Cities of Youth' Erasmus+ KA2 project, we asked our participant Anano questions about her impressions of the project and what she's learned so far





Anano is a 21-year-old girl who's OBSESSED with Droni



Mariam is a 21-year-old girl who studies at the Faculty of Psychology, she always tries to be active and gain new experiences


