BLUE AND YELLOW



From the then coat of arms, three crowns.

CROSS



Inspired by "Dannebrog" of Denmark.

Sillsallaten(Union flag)



When Sweden joined the union with Norway in 1814 but they got the flag 1844. Year 1906 came our law how the Swedish flag should look like which color of blue and yellow.

Oense(disagree)



Our flag was always a counter flag against our rival Denmark. So we call it the oense(disagree) flag

Trilingual Flag



Old flag for the Kings Fleet and only the Swedish fleet/army could use it after 1600 a.f.kr. You can still see this flag today on our fleet

OTHER THEORY

Flag appeared on the sky to Erik the Holy when he came to Finland during the first swedish crusades.
